

Qualities of a Safety Hand Member Role Play Activity

Warm up activity: As a class activity, brainstorm the different sorts of people we may consider to be part of our Safety Hand. For example, a parent, a relative not living with us, teacher, coach, neighbour, friend's parent, Kids Helpline, pastor.

Instructions: Form small groups of 3 - 4. Give, or ask each group to select, a desired quality of a Safety Hand Member (some examples are listed below). Ask the group to prepare a short role play to demonstrate this quality to the class. They can use any of the relationships from the warm up activity as a context.

After each group performs the role play, the class must guess the quality of a Safety Hand Member that is being demonstrated. Record all qualities on the board.

Qualities may include:

- Respectful
- Compassionate
- Good communicator
- Trustworthy
- Caring
- Non-judgemental
- Good listener
- Supportive

Ask: *Do you know adults with a lot of these qualities?*

How can we make sure our Safety Hand Members have a number of these qualities?
