Q1: My body belongs to me. Your body belongs to you. What does this mean?

- I need to respect other people's choices about their bodies.

Q2: What are the names of private parts for

Q3: What are the rules about our private parts?

- No one is allowed to touch or look at my private parts.
- No one is allowed to make me touch or look at their private parts.
- No one is allowed to show me rude pictures or take photos of my private parts.
- My mouth is a special private part. No one is allowed to stick anything yucky in my mouth.

Q4: What are the two types of secrets and how do they generally make us feel?

- 1. safe: happy, excited
- 2. unsafe: scared, worried, sad or confused
